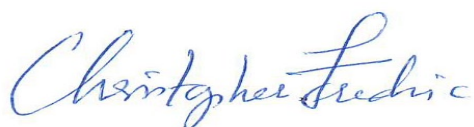
RE: ColActive® Plus Powder (Ag) – Applicability of European requirements for hazardous substances

This statement serves to clarify the applicability of European requirements and restrictions related to the import and use of hazardous substances in ColActive® Plus Powder (Ag) products.

ColActive® Plus Powder (Ag) is a collagen powder made from collagen, sodium alginate, carboxymethyl cellulose (CMC), ethylenediaminetetraacetic acid (EDTA) and Silver in the Ag formulation.

A summary of applicability of the European Directives on hazardous substances for ColActive® Plus Powder (Ag) is outlined below:

Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS) Directive 2011/65/EU	Restriction of the use of hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment	Not applicable. ColActive® Plus Powder (Ag) is not an electric or electronic piece of equipment
Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS) Directive 2011/65/EU	Restriction of import of certain chemicals and substances, including substances of very high concern (SVHC) (Article 57)	Not applicable. ColActive® Plus Powder (Ag) does not contain materials restricted under REACH regulation 1907/2006, including SVHC as defined in Article 57 of the regulation. The materials used for ColActive® Plus Powder (Ag) products were searched in the ECHA database of substances restricted under REACH ¹ and REACH SVHC Finder online tool ² to confirm that they are not restricted.
